

## SAWYER COUNTY Employment and Skills Training

**Occupational skills training**-instruction of a standardized set of competencies which are applicable to a wide range of work setting or a specific skill set for an individual job

## SAWYER COUNTY Leadership Development

Examples:

- Community and service learning projects
- Organizational and team leadership training
- Training in decision-making, setting priorities, etc.
- Budgeting of resources/financial literacy training
